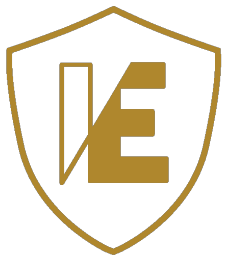

The Ivy Edge Method

The Ivy Edge Method is comprised of five areas of focus designed to measure a student's progress in developing themselves into strong and compelling applicants to selective colleges. These areas are as follows:

- ❖ **Academic Planning & Course Selection**
- ❖ **Leadership Development & Extracurricular Opportunities**
- ❖ **Personal Growth & Development**
- ❖ **Global Citizenry & Opportunities for Service**
- ❖ **Distinguished Excellence**

Students meet for one-hour on a bi-weekly basis for personalized coaching sessions designed to develop them in these areas during their high school career. Students also receive one-on-one guidance on all aspects of the college application process up until the student decides which college they will attend.

Description & Fees of Service Plans

The Ivy Edge's service plans are long-term engagements. Plans assume twenty (20) weeks in a semester, and ten (10) hour-long sessions each semester. The types and hours of service plans are as follows:

- ❖ **Freshman Year Plan (Fall/Spring)**
 - *Eighty (80) hours/Seventy (70) hours*
- ❖ **Sophomore Year Plan (Fall/Spring)**
 - *Sixty (60) hours/Fifty (50) hours*
- ❖ **Junior Year Plan (Fall/Spring)**
 - *Forty (40) hours/Thirty (30) hours*
- ❖ **Senior Year Plan***
 - *Twenty (20) hours*

All service plans end May 1st of the student's senior year, traditionally known as College Decision Day. The hourly fee for each service plan is \$375/hr. Service plans are prorated based on student's start date.

*The Tier IV Plan is not prorated.

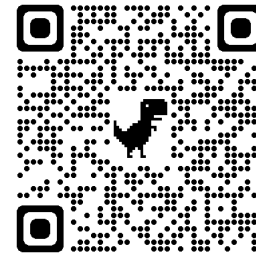
